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QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FOR WP11334

APPOINTMENT OF A PANEL OF EXPERTS IN THE FIELD OF FORENSIC AUDIT AND INVESTIGATIONS TO BE APPOINTED TO ASSIST THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND SANITATION WITH INVESTIGATION OF PROJECTS AS AND WHEN NECESSARY FOR A PERIOD OF THREE(3) YEARS

Question 1

I am reaching out on behalf of StoneTurn South Africa (Pty) Ltd. We are interested in responding to RFB WP11334.

I note that per paragraph 5.5 of the TOR, the bidding company should be existence for 3 years.

Our offices in South Africa has been in existence for 2 years, however globally, we have been in existence for 15 years. Would that be sufficient to meet the requirement of par 5.5?

Answer 1

It remains the prerogative of the Service Provider to provide the necessary information to substantiate the experience and existence of the company. Please also refer to Evaluation Criteria, Paragraph 2.1. for further detail.

Question 2

We have noted that the department is seeking to appoint cyber/digital forensic experts as part of the panel, would the department therefore consider the evaluation of these experts separate to those of the "normal" forensic investigations? Our reason for asking is that different qualifying criteria is adhered to by digital forensic experts.

Answer 2

Unfortunately not. The criteria was designed with the view to appoint service providers who can respond to any complaint that may be referred to them regardless of whether it is a cyber-incident or not.

Question 3

Will the department consider a company such as ours that specialises in cyber/ digital forensic investigations, E-Discovery specialist, Cyber Incident Response services and litigation support services. Or is the department seeking to appoint a supplier that has all the listed requested services in-house?

Answer 3

The Listed Specification Requirements will all be evaluated to determine the successful bidder. Please refer to Evaluation Criteria attached to the TOR as well as allocated points in this regard.

Question 4

On page 8 point 5.5: The bidding company must be in existence for at least 3 years with 3 years relevant experience in delivering the required forensic services.

Answer 4

This is not a disqualification criteria. The Listed Specification Requirements will all be evaluated to determine the successful bidder.

Experience will be evaluated in terms of the Evaluation Criteria, Paragraph 2.1.

What does the Department suggest as proof of years of existence as referred to on page 8 point 5.5.1 of the terms of reference, if CIPC certificate may not be used?

Answer 7

- 5.5.2. Proof of relevant experience by the firm should be provided by means of case studies detailing the type of projects, the period of the projects, the magnitude of the projects and the result of the projects in the past three (3) years. Reference letters from former clients must be attached. The case studies must include the following information:
 - type and nature of investigation conducted;
 - actual hours or days spent in concluding the investigation;
 - · value adding recommendations made during the investigation;
 - · outcome of the investigation;
 - any successful criminal prosecutions or convictions; and
 - Provide a list of (3) three references of the previous investigation work done in the past 3 years. The list should contain the client's name, the contact person and the contact details.

NB: the Department of Water & Sanitation reserves the right to vet all documentation and information provided by bidders to prove their relevant experience and ability to perform the service.

Should any copies additional to the original proposal be submitted as well?

BAS" Entity maintenance must be completely filled and attached to the bid document. Bank confirmation letter is insufficient in place of the BAS entity maintenance form.

Question 11

Keeping in mind businesses' current working from home status due to Covid-19, would it be permitted to sign SBD's using an electronic signature?

The signatures on all the SBD forms must be original not electronic.

Question 12

I have a question about page 8. It says the CVs must be submitted in a form on a table. When it comes to case studies or other relevant reference. Does it mean each person must have their own reference to prove relevant experience and knowledge in field of expertise? I would really like some clarity. Your response would be highly appreciated.

Answer 12

Yes. It must be done in the prescribed format.

- 5.4.1. 1st column: name and id number of key staff member;
- 5.4.2. 2nd column: relevant qualification(s) and courses successfully completed;
- 3rd column: number of years' relevant experience indicated in numerical format; and
- 5.4.4. 4th column: case studies to prove relevant experience and knowledge in field of expertise (as indicated in below table).

Definition of case studies: Investigation assignments that have been previously undertaken in the past three years.
