- (1)(a) The number of water use license applications that is currently being processed is about 1 592.
- (1)(b) The breakdown of water use licenses per sector is as follows:

Sector	Number of Licenses processed
Agriculture	468
Power generation (Eskom)	3
Local Municipality (Includes other Gov. agencies)	117
Stream Flow Reduction Activities	274
Mining	330
Others (include other industries, property developers, etc)	400
Totals	1 592
