TOILET USERS UNITE

A flush toilet isn't always the best option.

Dry on-site toilets are a great alternative for water-scarce areas or where a sewerage system is not available. Clean toilets keep users healthy.



After using the toilet, remember to use soap and water to remove germs from your hands.

If the toilet is full, there are a few options:

- 1 Contact a service provider to empty your pit, or ask the municipality to help if they have an emptying programme.
- 2 Move the top structure to a new safe pit.
- 3 Build a new toilet yourself. Comply with the technical specifications.



Rubbish in the pit makes it difficult to empty the toilet. **Only put human waste and wiping materials in the toilet.**

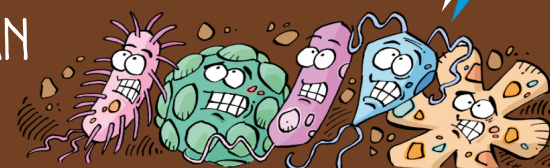


Did you know that sludge is not just waste? Treated sludge can become useful products like fuel briquettes, building materials, biogas, fertiliser, compost and more.
