The Lusushwane Bulk Water Supply project is aimed at providing water to the residents of Chief Albert Luthuli Municipality. On completion of Phase 3, the project will provide an uninterrupted water supply to the Chief Albert Luthuli Local Municipality residents who reside nearby the country's border with Swaziland. The communities that will benefit from the project include amongst others Bettysgoed, Smithfields, Oshoek, Lochiel, Robinsdale, Aankomst, Pampoen, Houtbosch and Hartbeeskop.
