Minister Mokonyane to launch the Jozini Regional Water Treatment Works

10 August 2017

The Minister of Water and Sanitation Mrs. Nomvula Mokonyane will launch the Jozini Regional Water Treatment Works on Saturday, 19 August 2017 at oThobothini Sports Field in Jozini, north of KwaZulu-Natal.

The Jozini Regional Water Treatment Works is located in the Local Municipality area of Jozini under the uMkhanyakude District Municipality and it forms part of the Jozini Bulk Water Supply Project. The primary focus of Jozini Regional Water Treatment Works is to supply potable water to rural communities within the Jozini Local Municipality. The 40ML/Day water treatments works will provide about 134 864 (approximately 16,200 households) people north of Jozini with sustainable water supply.

The UMkhanyakude District Municipality is responsible for providing water and sanitation services in all Local Municipalities within its jurisdiction, i.e. UMhlabuyalingana, Jozini, The Big Five False Bay, Hlabisa and Mtubatuba.
