DWS and partners to clean-up Klip River

12 March 2020

The Klip River Water Stewardship Initiative (KlipWaS) in partnership with the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS), the International Water Management Institute (IWMI), the Strategic Water Partners Network (SWPN), Coca-Cola, Shoprite, Plastics-SA and several others, will clean-up Klip River in Johannesburg, on Friday, 13 March, 2020.
