Deputy Minister Magadzi to assess the state of water infrastructure in Sekhukhune District Municipality

The Deputy Minister of Water and Sanitation, Ms Dikeledi Magadzi will visit Nebo Plateau in Sekhukhune District Municipality to assess the state of water infrastructure in the area on Friday, 01 October 2021.

During the visit, Deputy Minister Magadzi will meet various stakeholders including the Sekhukhune District Municipality Executive Mayor, Cllr Keamotseng Stanley Ramaila and Fetakgomo Tubatse Local Municipality Mayor, Cllr Ralipane Samuel Mamekoa to devise plans that will see uninterrupted water supply in the area.

This will be followed by a site visit to Ga-Malekana Water Treatment Works to assess the state of the plant.

Deputy Minister Magadzi will conclude the visit with a community engagement in Buffelskloof where she will lend an ear to community members about the water challenges they experience in the area.

Minister Senzo Mchunu and his deputies visited the province early this month and made an undertaking that all the water challenges in the province will be treated with renewed vigor and will receive urgent attention.
