Deputy President to undertake an oversight visit to Emfuleni Local Municipality

22 March 2021

Deputy President David Mabuza will tomorrow, 23 March 2021 conduct an oversight visit to Sebokeng, in the Emfuleni Local Municipality. The visit is part of the work of the Inter-Ministerial Committee on Service Delivery and the commitment made by the Deputy President in the National Council of Provinces and National Assembly that he would ensure that the service delivery challenges of the community are addressed.

During the visit, Deputy President Mabuza will receive a briefing on the Section 63 (as per Water Services Act; Act 108 of 1997) intervention at the Water Services Authority to rehabilitate Vaal River System in terms of water and to capacitate the municipality to sustainably manage water services operation as well progress made under Section 139 (b) of the Constitution.

The oversight visit will take place at the Emfuleni Water Waste Treatment Plant where module 6 of the Sebokeng Regional Sewer Scheme will be showcased.

The visit is also undertaken within the context of the the District Development Model which calls for greater intergovernmental integration, inclusive development and accelerated service delivery to address challenges confronting municipalities.

The Deputy President will be accompanied by the Premier of Gauteng, Mr David Makhura, the Minister of Human Settlements, Water and Sanitation, Ms Lindiwe Sisulu, the Deputy Minister of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs, Mr Obed Bapela, the Deputy Minister of Trade, Industry and Competition, Mr Fikile Majola, and the Gauteng MEC Human Settlements, Urban Planning and CoGTA, Mr Lebogang Maile.
