This task will be carried out on more than one inspection day with the first being **Tuesday**, **6 September** and the second one **Thursday**, **8 September 2022**.

The meeting will be at 09:00 on the steps entering the main administration building. The inspections days are planned to start at 09:00 and end at 15:00. This may however change depending on progress.
