National Ministerial Water Sector Sustainability Symposium aims to get expert opinion on South Africa's state of water

22 May 2023

Members of the media are invited to a National Ministerial Water Sector Sustainability Symposium aimed at taking stock of the current state of the water sector by experts in the Department of Water and Sanitation, including some the country's leading independent water experts who will offer advice that will form future policy position of the Department.

The symposium will be a focussed and directed engagement with topics covering areas including water resource security, financial sustainability, service delivery sustainability, pricing and tariffs, and regulation of water services.
