Minister Majodina to unpack 2026/27 Budget Vote and water sector priorities

16 June 2026

Members of the media are invited to a stakeholder and media engagement session hosted by the Minister of Water and Sanitation, Ms Pemmy Majodina, together with Deputy Ministers David Mahlobo and Sello Seithloho, on Thursday, 18 June 2026, at Southern Sun Cape Sun Hotel, Cape Town.

The engagement follows the tabling of the Department of Water and Sanitation's 2026/27 Budget Vote before the National Assembly and the National Council of Provinces (NCOP). Minister Majodina will unpack the Budget Vote, outlining the department's strategic priorities, key allocations and planned interventions aimed at strengthening water security, accelerating infrastructure development, improving sanitation services and ensuring the long-term sustainability of the water sector.

The Minister will be supported by senior officials from the Department of Water and Sanitation, representatives from the Association of Water and Sanitation Institute of South Africa (AWSISA), who will provide further insights into the sector's programmes and implementation plans.

This engagement provides an opportunity for stakeholders and members of the media to engage directly with the Ministry, departmental leadership and water entities' board members on key policy, governance, infrastructure and funding matters.
