

The Director-General of the Department of Water and Sanitation, Dr Sean Phillips, recently approved the Eutrophication Management Strategy for South Africa (EMSSA), which primarily deals with the management of anthropogenic eutrophication. The Strategy aims to mitigate excessive nutrient enrichment in water bodies, protect water ecosystems and secure water resources that are suitable for various uses. It also addresses nutrient inputs from agricultural, industrial, mining, and urban sources, along with wastewater treatment plants. The strategy aligns with national goals, including the Integrated Water Quality Management Strategy (IWQMS) and the National Water Resource Strategy (NWRS), aiming to transform the water and sanitation sector regarding eutrophication management and pollution prevention.
