Leaks can waste a lot of water, especially if they are undetected or underground and left for a long time. Leaks on your property are your responsibility. So here is a guide to finding and fixing them quickly, to save water and save you money.
 YOUR LOCAL MUNICIPALITY

If you can't afford to call a plumber to fix a serious toilet problem, use the little stopcock/angle valve tap at the base of the toilet to keep it turned off between flushes.

IF THERE IS A DIFFERENCE,
If the number on increased, it means you have a leak and you need to take action as per the City's By-law.

CALL A PLUMBER TO HELP FIX THE LEAK
Unless it's a simple DIY job.

One leaking toilet wastes between 2600 and 13000 litres per month, depending on the flow rate of the leak. A leaking tap wastes between 400 and 2600 litres per month.

Press a piece of toilet paper against the inside back surface of the bow a leak.


3 SIMPLE TESTS FOR A TOLLET LEAK

Listen for water trickling into the toilet bowl.
