SUPPORT STAFF

Each Provincial Team of 6 learners will be supported by officials from the Department of Water and Sanitation and the Department of Basic Education. They will be responsible for logistical arrangements, accompanying the learners to and from the event from their respective provinces and supervising the learners.

WHAT PRIZES CAN BE WON?

Three (3) trophies for the three (3) top performing teams.

Twenty seven (27) bursaries awarded to the twenty seven (27) top performing learners to pursue water and sanitation related careers.

Certificates for twenty seven (27) top performing learners.

MOBILISATION OF SCHOOLS

To ensure that both rural and urban schools are exposed to equal opportunities, new schools must be mobilised each year. For National Adjudication all Provinces are expected to bring teams from schools that have never participated in the Project. Non-compliance will result to disqualification of teams.

The Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) is committed to mobilising citizens to participate in World Water Monitoring Day (WWMD) each year. WWMD is celebrated internationally on 18 September, and people around the world are encouraged to find ways to monitor the quality of their water.

AQUA ENDURO seeks to bring together young people from around the country for a week-long event filled with Water activities, sport & games. The idea is to engage young people in mental and physical activities that test their intellectual capabilities and stamina while learning about the importance of Water and what it entails.

A one-pager detailing in:

- 1 Paragraph why you are interested in the water field
- 2 Paragraphs on how you plan to promote World Water Monitoring Day at your school
- 1 Paragraph motivating why the Department of Water and Sanitation should consider you for participation

Applications not complying with any of these requirements will be disqualified automatically.

Applications with all the requirements should reach the postal address by no later than March.

All entrants must be prepared to submit themselves to the rules of the adjudication.
