

INTRODUCTION


Definition:

- Eutrophication is defined as a process of nutrient enrichment and the associated excessive plant growth such as algae and macrophytes in water bodies, which can be seen as either a natural aging process in lakes or accelerated by human impacts (Point and Non-Point sources of pollution).
- Factors influencing eutrophication are high nutrient concentrations, prolonged periods of water stagnation, conducive temperature, oxygen concentration and proper light regime.


