REQUEST FOR SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND CONFIGURATION OF AN ENVIORACK AT BOSKOP DAM OFFICE



1. BACKGROUND

In order to deliver against its mandate the Department of Water And Sanitation (DWS) need to improve its efficiency, effectiveness, security and information reliability to deliver more – better, faster, and cost effectively with the relevant controls in terms of best practice and good governance. A key element in this drive towards effectiveness and efficiency is the use of ICT that within the DWS environment nationally.

2. CURRENT ENVIRONMENT

The Boskop Dam Office currently is utilizing the old server room infrastructure which is not only out dated but is not conducive to accommodate servers and has repeatedly attracted internal and external Audit queries.

A route cause analysis was conducted and one of the recommendations was that a proper data center must be put in place with the capabilities of monitoring humidity, fire, temperature, power loss and access control basically monitored environment.

3. SERVICE REQUIRED

The Department requires a service from a professional service provider to supply, install and configure an EnviroRac in the dedicated room, do the necessary repairs and issue a certificate of compliance. An inspection accompanied by all relevant documentation “*to be provided by the installer*” will be done after all work has been completed before sign off.

4. SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work is for the supply, installation and configuration of the EnviroRac on site as per technical specification and requirements.

5. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Department of Water and Sanitation will evaluate all proposals in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022. - All Standard Bidding Documents must be fully completed and signed.
- Only CSD registered companies will be appointed.

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PHASE 3: POINTS AWARDED FOR B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL OF CONTRIBUTION

In terms of Regulation 5 (2) and 6 (2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

- The Department will not be liable to any damage caused by the contractor, whatsoever.
- The Department will not be held liable of injury of the contractors employees
- Bidders are requested to provide a clear agreement regarding joint venture/consortia. The percentage involvement of each company in the joint venture agreement should be indicated on the agreement. A trust, consortium or joint venture must submit a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate for every separate bid.
- A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the bid documents that such a bidder intends sub-contracting more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the points that such a bidder qualifies for, unless the intended sub-contractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.
- Bidders are required to submit original and valid B-BBEE Status level Verification Certificate or certified copies thereof together with their bids, to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims.
- Bidders who do not submit B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or are non-compliant contributors to B-BBEE do not qualify for preference points for B-BBEE but should not be disqualified from the bidding process. They will score points out of 80 for price only and zero (0) points out of 20 for B-BBEE. A trust, consortium or joint venture must submit a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate.
- It is a requirement that bidders who do business with government must comply to the relevant tax legislations and bidders are required to submit an **ORIGINAL AND VALID** Tax Clearance Certificate as issued by SARS. Failure to submit such will invalid your bid.

7. SITE VISIT AND CONTACT



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Please take note a site visit will be required. The date and venue of the compulsory site visit will be communicated. It is important that service providers confirm all required details during the briefing session as the prices quote will be fixed and no deviation whatsoever will be tolerated once the bid is allocated.
