THE ROLE OF PROJECT STEERING COMMITTEE (PSC)

- **Non-statutory, voluntary body;**
- **Oversight body for the classification project for the water resources within the Olifants Doorn WMA;**
- **To guide the project in all stages as it unfolds;**
- **To provide inputs on behalf of the sector it represents.**



THE OBJECTIVES (1)

- **Provide strategic direction and guidance on the study process and tasks;**
- **Guide the study team on the desired state of water resources within the Olifants/Doorn WMA;**
- **Provide technical input, support and information to the process where available.**

THE OBJECTIVES (2)

- Provide direction on the significant water resources to be classified;
- Provide input to the technical process;
- Serve as representatives of the stakeholder bodies and organisations and report back to them on an ongoing basis regarding the study decisions and results.
