
AGREEMENT



1. THE PARTIES AGREE THAT THE APPEAL BE SUSPENDED SUBJECT TO:
 - 1.1 Additional documents will be placed before the Respondents to re-consider the application within
 - 1.2 7 days thereof.
 - 1.2 The Respondents will re-consider the application and will render its decision to the appellant within 30 days of receipt of the additional documents.
 - 1.3 Should the application be successful the matter will be withdrawn.
 - 1.4 Should the re-consideration not be in favour of the appellant the appeal will proceed as of the hereof.

1.5 The parties record that Appellant and Respondent have addressed the Respondent's letter to the issue of Tribunal's duty to show as well as the duty of Appellant being a director in this regard. The Tribunal will review its decision until the process set out in par 1.1 - 1.4 has been concluded.

1.6 Should the Appellant wish to proceed with the appeal it will notify the Registrar of the Tribunal and the Tribunal will only then proceed to consider and issue its decision.
