Sanitation education taken to schools in Gert Sibande District

The Department for Water and Sanitation (DWS) and the Inkomati-Usuthu Catchment Management Agency (IUCMA) embarked on a week-long water conservation and career awareness campaign targeting rural schools in the Usuthu sub-catchment during the week of 24 – 28 May 2021.

The campaign targeted learners from schools such as Rev. SA Nkosi High, Warburton Combined, Zandelingspost Combined and Ubuhlebuzile High in the Gert Sibande District, Mpumalanga Province.

Ms Liketso Khaile from IUCMA outlined the role of the agency in water resources management and encouraged the learners to assist the institution in preventing the pollution of the water resources.

Mr Themba Khoza from DWS outlined the role of the Department and reminded the learners that South Africa is a dry and water scarce country. He called on the learners to play their part in ensuring water security by protecting the water resources and using the available water in a wise and conservative manner.

As part of the awareness campaign, the learners were also exposed to careers in the water sector.
