- Whether any further section 19(3) notices have been issued against municipalities in Mpumalanga; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details?

Kungwini Local Municipality	The complaint was a once off incident which involved the residents complaining about a sewer smell. The Municipality attended to it and no further complaints have been received regarding this matter.	The Municipality attended to this problem since it was a once off incident and this matter was resolved	
Greater Sekhukhune District Municipality (although this municipality falls in Limpopo the water quality issues are handled by the Mpamalanga office as part of the Olifants River catchment)	A section 19(3) and 53(1) directive dated 23/02/2010 was issued for the Burgersfort Sewage Treatment Works	My Department still awaits response from the Municipality. The letter indicated that based on the site inspection the municipality has failed to implement the measures stipulated in the action plan. 	My Department wrote a letter dated 24/03/2010 to Bushbuckridge Local Municipality indicating that the Department has transferred an amount of R 5.16 million towards the Accelerated Community Infrastructure Programme (ACIP) toward the refurbishment/ upgrade of wastewater treatment works in Bushbuckridge Municipality to resolve the problems of wastewater treatment. One of the problems identified was that these WWTW are old and cannot cope with the current sewage flow because of the population growth and development taking place.		
Nkomazi Local Municipality	A directive in terms of section 19(3) and 53(1) dated 12/10/2009 was issued to the municipality.	The municipality responded through a letter dated 25/11/2009 indicating that they have appointed a consultant and a contractor to address the challenges of sewage overflow.	
Mbombela Local Municipality	A water use license for the upgrade of the White River Sewage Treatment Works was issued on the 19/10/2009 with conditions for the Municipality to comply with.	No response received from the Municipality.

A criminal case with the eMalahleni SAPS was opened on 24 th of November 2009 against eMalahleni Local Municipality for failing to comply with a section 19(3) directive, for engaging in a water use activity without authorisation and for unlawfully and intentionally or negligently committing any act or omission which pollutes or is likely to pollute a water resource.	My Department has transferred R 5 Million to the Municipality through the ACIP project. The Municipality has appointed Rand Water to assist with problems of sewage pollution at eMalahleni Local Municipality.	
Emakhazeni Local Municipality	A notice in terms of section 53(1) dated 17/08/2008 was issued to Emakhazeni Local Municipality for failing to comply with the license condition for the Emthonjeni wastewater treatment works. A reminder letter dated 16/11/2009 was issued to the municipality to make representation on the above notice. After the Municipality failed to respond to the above notices a directive dated 23/02/2010 was issued to the Municipality directing them to rectify the identified non compliances to the license conditions.
