- (a) My Department in collaboration with the South African Bureau of Standards and other stakeholders are reviewing the 2006 SANS 241 and this process started the beginning of 2009. This is earlier than the accepted five year cycle.
- (b) Once published, municipalities are expected to immediately comply with the revised standard.
