- (a) Yes, the Department reviewed its organogram as required in the 2008-09 financial year.
- (b) No, the Department did not review its organogram for the 2010-11 financial year however, I as the Minister appointed a Structure Review Committee during the 2011-12 financial year and the process is currently still underway.
- (b)(i) Yes, job evaluations have been done however, the processes still depend on the finalisation of the structure review which is currently still underway.
- (b)(ii) No, the abolition of redundant posts also depends on the finalisation of the structure review process which is still underway.
