South Africa has strong bilateral relations in the field of Water and Sanitation with the Government of Cuba which has spanned over a period of over 10 years.

The obligation to which the Minister referred to arises from the International Agreement between the Republic of South Africa with the Government of Cuba which was signed on 6 February 2020. The Agreement was tabled and ratified by Parliament on 19 November 2020, in accordance with Chapter 14 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, section 231 (3).
