MINISTER OF WATER AND SANITATION

The Directives issued by the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) detailed measures required for implementation by the eThekwini Metropolitan Municipality including:

- The control of pollution incidents and prevention thereof
- Prevention and remedying the effects of pollution emanating from the various wastewater treatment works as well as associated sewerage infrastructure and resultant pollution affecting the environment and water resources.
- Assessment of the integrity of the sewerage infrastructure causing pollution
- Implementation of short term intervention measures to stop pollution emanating from burst pipes, broken manholes, malfunctioning pump stations and/or other related damaged sewerage infrastructure discharging into water resources.

- Assessment of the extent of the environmental impact caused by the flooding and submit an Action Plan with timeframes and required funding.
- Compilation and submission of a Rehabilitation and Remediation Plan for approval prior to implementation.

The DWS filed papers pursuant to the order against the eThekwini Metropolitan Municipality in the KwaZulu-Natal High Court, Durban on 02 December 2022.
