Ward 12 falls under Emfuleni Local Municipality's distribution network. Rand Water supplies Emfuleni with water that meets drinking water standards. The Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) and Rand Water have not received any complaints from the Municipality regarding water shortages in Ward 12 in recent years. Currently, like many other areas in Gauteng, there have been areas that received intermittent water supply which was mainly attributed to power supply outages.
