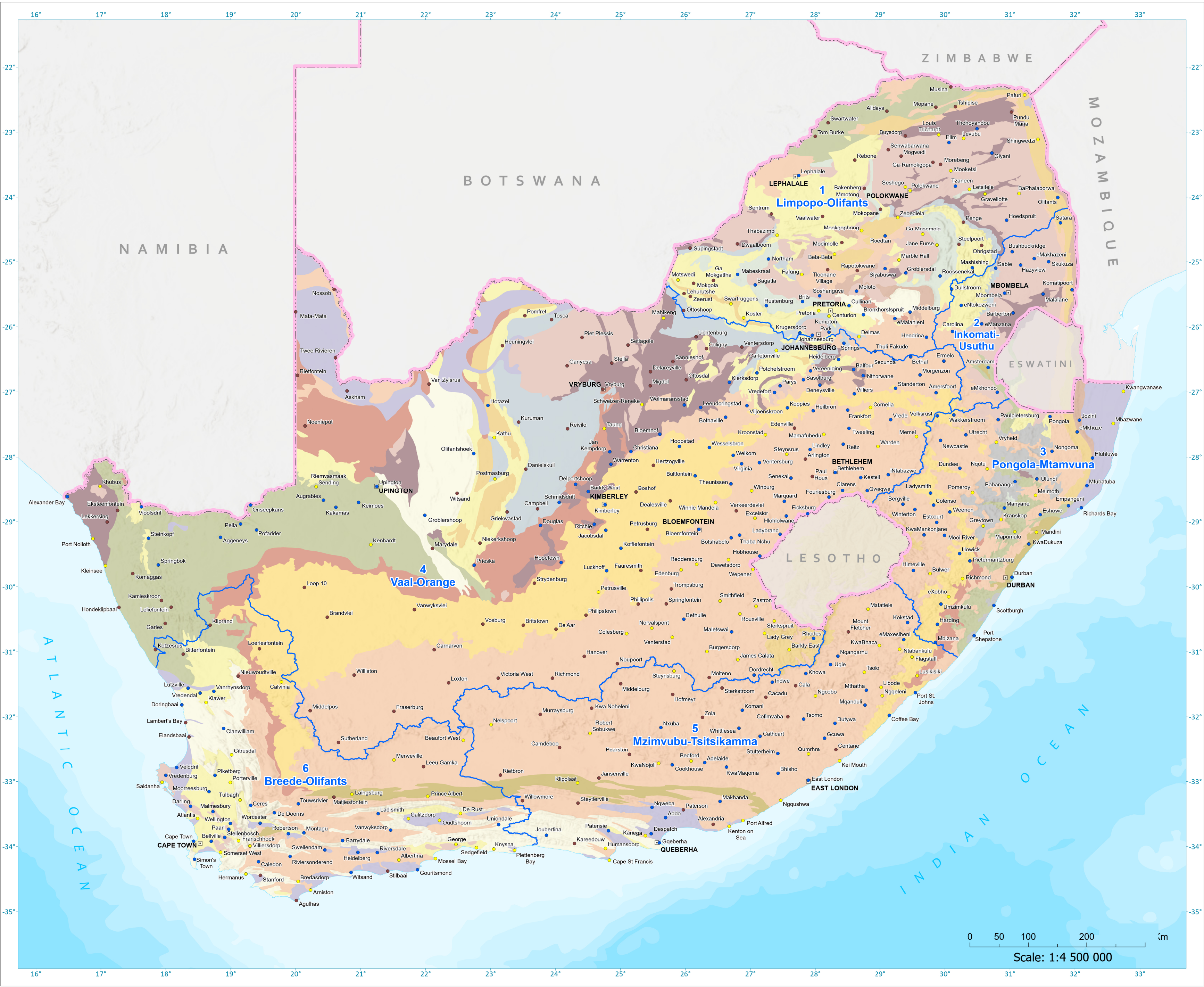




Water Source Dependent Towns and Simplified Geology of the Republic of South Africa

- Compact sedimentary strata
- Basic / Mafic and ultramafic intrusives
- Undifferentiated assemblage of compact sedimentary extrusive and intrusive rocks
- Principally arenaceous strata
- Porous unconsolidated and consolidated sedimentary strata
- Principally argillaceous strata
- Acid and intermediate lavas
- Intercalated arenaceous and argillaceous strata
- Basic / Mafic lavas
- Assemblage of tillite and shale
- Dolomite and limestone
- Assemblage of tillite, shale and sandstone
- Tillite
- Acid and intermediate extrusives
- Intercalated assemblage of compact sedimentary and extrusive rocks
