This serves as notification of the proposed **Development of Foxwood Dam**, as well as the upcoming public meeting that will be held to present the project. #### **PROJECT OVERVIEW:**

The Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) is investigating the feasibility of developing a multi-purpose dam (known as Foxwood Dam) on the Koonap River outside of Adelaide, which falls within the Nxuba Local Municipality in the Amathole District Municipality in the Eastern Cape.

The development of Foxwood Dam could provide additional assurance of domestic water supply within the region. In addition, the dam has the potential to mobilize the water resources to allow for downstream irrigation development.

#### **APPLICATION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATIONS:**

Nemai Consulting was appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) by DWS to conduct the Scoping and Environmental Impact Reporting process contemplated in Regulation 21 to Regulation 24 of Government Notice No. R. 982 of 4 December 2014.

In addition, approval will also be sought for water uses in terms of Section 21 of the National Water Act (Act No. 36 of 1998), as well as quarries and borrow pits in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act (Act No. 28 of 2002).
