2.1) Potential issues or concerns associated with the project?

South Africa is a watershortage country and any dam to be built should be to the maximum size irrespective of whether it is for irrigation or any other reason-this water or the majority of it will be for human consumption, The bulk of the Fish river water will possibly go to Port Elizabeth and then Grahamstown and possibly Port Alfred/Kenton could be supplied from Foxwood.

2.2) Specific requirements in terms of the EIA process?


Scrap the relocation of the existing canal —enough money has already been wasted on this project which was designed for Adelaide in 1931!
Scrap the alignment of the road MR00639 because the length of the bridge where it crosses the dam is about the same length as the dam wall ,so put the road over the dam wall or scrap it altogether as it does not have a great deal of traffic over it.
The pipeline from Foxwood into present pipeline should rather go to the existing dam as a backup supply in case there is a breakdown with the pump
For the irrigation downstream it would be advisable to pipe the water to save water through evaporation in Times of severe drought and to have non-polluted water(fertilizer through leaching) and the further downstream Water would be under pressure and save electricity costs.
