

National Problem Statement The <u>Honourable President Jacob Zuma</u> statement during the State of the Nation address said "We are not a water rich country. Yet we still lose a lot of water through leaking pipes and inadequate infrastructure. We will be putting in place measures to reduce our water loss by half by 200 ard". The <u>Honourable Minister Buyelwa Sonjica</u> stated: Water demand is expected to rise by 53% over the next 30 years while supply of water is likely to decline if current trends due to leakage from old and poorly maintained municipal infrastructure and the loss of yeardands persist. This would make the prospect of water shortage a frightening reality on the near future. To enable more efficient management of our water resources, the following targets are critical: • Reduction of water loss from distribution networks from current levels of approximately 30% to 1%% by 2014 coupled with encouraging users to save water.
