The proposed mining permit (GP 30/5/1/3/2 (10289) MP) for the **Kimberley West** opencast pit will be located on a portion of Portion 1 of the Farm Witpoortjie 245 IQ, a portion of the Remainder of Portion 14 of the Farm Rooodepoort 237 IQ. A portion of the waste rock dump will be located on a portion of Portion 92 of the Farm Vlakfontein 238 IQ and a section of the access/haul road will be located on a portion of the Remainder of Portion 1 of the Farm Vlakfontein 238 IQ, Gauteng Province.
