Area subject to regular drought conditions - river flows for short period only after good rains in catchment area  
 - Hartebeespoort Dam.

Between years 1980 and 1990 Crocodile river was dry due to construction of Rodekoppies Dam and there was a noticeable impact on trees - a number of them died off!

Loss of income - we grow lucern - the farm has riparian rights

SUGGEST: pipeline from Zambezi river - strong, reliable water all year round.
