Background

- · Possible illegal use putting VRS at risk
- Gauteng and Free State Regions have been undertaking Validation and
- Validation completed in Upper and Middle Vaal WMAs commenced in Lower Vaal WMA
- Estimated 244 x $10^6 \text{m}^3 \text{a}$ possible illegal use
- Upper Vaal $\,$ 180 x 10 $^6m^3/a$ (verification- 15% finalised, 56% in process)
- -Middle Vaal $\,$ 34 $\,$ x $10^6m^3/a$ (verification- 13% finalised, 60% in process)
- -Lower Vaal 30 x 106m3/a (verification- not yet started)

 - Project Management
 - Completing Validation and Verification
 Developing sustainable CME

 - Developing Contingency Plans
 - Communication
- · Project duration 3 years

Priority Areas

- Priority case lists based on the volume of the possible unlawful use on each property.
- The initial focus on properties with possible unlawful use of more than 250 000 m³/a (surface water).

Priority Areas - (Cont.)

- Regulations to enforce measurement of taking is a prerequisite for action against partially unlawful water
- Initial priority lists revised now properties where all the current water use was classified as possible unlawful use.

Regulations/Delegations

- Regulations
- Regulations required to enforce measurement
- Prerequisite for action against partially unlawful water users
- Process far advanced
- Internal consultations, as well as with State Legal Advisor completed
- Informal liaison with Organised Agriculture undertaken
- Once internal DWA consultations with Management concluded, submission to Minister to publish for Public comment
- **Delegations**
- Last approved delegations in 2005 structural and procedural changes in the Department had an influence on delegations.
- Proposal for the updating of delegations have been drafted for submission to

Compliance Monitoring and Enforcement (CME)

- Finalisation of standard procedure under way to guide CME process.
- · New CME appointments in Upper Vaal.
- \cdot $\,$ CME officials from Head Office made available to assist with CME process.
- Initial focus on "blatant" unlawful users and users who had to measure (permit conditions) little burden of proof.
- <u>Upper Vaal</u> 40% (354) of unlawful properties using 38% off illegal volume
- Middle Vaal
- 50 % (90) of unlawful properties using 44% off illegal volume
- After publishing of Regulations Partial unlawful users will be included in priority lists.

Compliance Monitoring and Enforcement (CME) (Cont.)

Other Activities

- Contingency Plan
 - Started identifying options
 - First discuss with role-players to prevent unnecessary work
- Communication
 - Communication plan developed
- Ties in with Region specific strategies and initiatives
- Commenced in Upper and Middle Vaal WMAs

Summary and Conclusion

- Eradication of all unlawful use in Vaal River System will not be met by 2011
- Validation completed in Upper and Middle Vaal WMAs and has commenced in the Lower Vaal WMA.
- · Verification underway in Upper and Middle Vaal WMAs
- Preparation for publishing Regulations for measuring irrigation water in process together with revision of delegations.
- Present focus of CME is on "blatant" unlawful use which represents 39% of total possible unlawful use.
- Programme with deliverables submitted Aim to address 92% of possible unlawful use in Vaal River System by March 2012.
