

### **Context of the Crocodile West System**



#### **Activities**

- Configured WRPM calibrated salinity modules
- Scenario formulation based on the following:
  - Revised water requirement scenarios for developments in Lephalale.
  - Interaction with the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality Consolidation of Feasibility Studies into a Bulk Water Master Plan Study.
  - Government's infrastructure development drive (details on next slides).
  - Incorporated information from other data sources.
- Undertook risk analysis with WRPM
- Prepare water balance for reconciliation scenarios
- Communication to Strategy Steering Committee

## Government's impetus for infrastructure development (1 of 2)

- President's State of the Nation Address:
  - Presidential Infrastructure Coordinating Commission (PICC), identified 17 strategic integrated projects (SIPs)
  - Strategic Integrated Projects (SIP) 1:
    - Intent to unlock the enormous mineral belt, Steelpoort and Waterberg (Lephalale Area)
    - Expand rail transport to Mpumalanga, connecting coalfields to power stations.

## Government's impetus for infrastructure development (2 of 2)

- Details on project planning and financing in the Budget Speech of the Minister of Finance
  - Consider impact on, and, economic viability of projects.
  - Mix of tax finance and cost recovery models.
- Speech on Budget Vote of the Minister of Water and Environmental Affairs
  - Construction of the Mokolo and Crocodile River (West) Water
     Augmentation Project underway (Phase 1).
  - Planning and optimisation of further augmentation to transfer surplus return flows from Crocodile West River to Lephalale (Phase 2).
