The DWS Director-General to meet with the water sector entities' CEOs

The Department of Water and Sanitation's (DWS) Director-General Ms. Margaret-Ann Diedricks will today Thursday 17 September host the top leadership of the nation's water sector entities, the Chief Executive Officers of water boards.

The water boards have a very important function within the sector, which is ensuring the use of their expertise to expedite the delivery of water and sanitation services country-wide.
