## THE DWS HOSTED SADC NATIONAL WATER WEEK-SA DRAWS TO A CLOSE

The SADC National Water Week-SA which has been held at the Protea Hotel Centurion from the 29<sup>th</sup> July will draw to a close tomorrow 31<sup>st</sup> July. This 3-day programme has been hosted by the Department of Water and Sanitation in collaboration with the Southern African Development Community, ably assisted by the Water Research Commission.

The main aim of this venture was to create a platform for country focused awareness-raising of the SADC Regional Water Programme and River Basin Organisations' initiatives towards the goal of improving water resources management and development. More importantly the workshop sought to harmonise national and local water management strategies with SADC Regional Strategies for better water resources management and development.
