Public Education Programme on saving water

The Department of Water and Sanitation in partnership with Ngaka Modiri Molema DM, Premier's office including its Mahikeng Local Municipality will be embarking on a Public Education Programme on 09 March 2016 at Mahikeng LM in Mahikeng.

The main purpose of the Programme is to inform and educate the public about the importance of saving water and the effects of drought. The Programme also aims to influence the public's behavior towards water usage.

Through this Programme, the Department of Water and Sanitation aims to reduce water wastage including better choices the public make when choosing water conservation appliances such as using a shower instead of a bath or washing their cars on the pavement instead of the lawn.

The programme for the day includes a School Based Education Programme where there will be demonstration of washing hands and water saving tips targeting school learners at Connie Minchin Primary School, water and sanitation presentations targeting the community at a Public Engagement Programme at St Joseph's hall in Lomanyaneng and a Roadshow Programme at Mahikeng taxi rank.
