President Zuma and Minister Mokonyane visit Giyani this Friday

27 October 2014

President Jacob Zuma together with the Minister of Water and Sanitation Nomvula Mokonyane will on 31 October 2014 visit Giyani, in Greater Giyani Local Municipality, Mopani District area of Limpopo.

The purpose of this visit is to launch the Giyani Water Treatment Works culminating in a Presidential Imbizo and as part of the Presidential Siyahloa Monitoring and Evaluation programme.

The water treatment works supplies 55 villages including Giyani Town with a combined population of 229 967 and the scheme is designed to provide household connections in the town and street taps at Reconstruction and Development Programme (RDP) level, i.e. 200 metres from a tap to a household in villages.
