

PHOTO LICENCE AGREEMENT

This Photo Licence Agreement is made among the following parties _____ (Contestant) and **South African National Committee for UNESCO Intergovernmental Hydrological Programme** (hereafter referred to as 'SANC for UNESCO IHP') and concerns any material related to the Citizen Science for Water Photo Story Competition 2024/25.

The contestant hereby grants SANC for UNESCO IHP a licence to use the submitted work (photos and story). This does not stop the contestant to grant licenses to other individuals or entities.

1. At all times, SANC for UNESCO IHP recognise the Photographer as the original content-creator and author of the respective images.
2. The contestant has made their submission to SANC for UNESCO IHP under the [Creative Commons Attribution-ShareAlike 4.0 International](#) (CC BY-SA 4.0), specified on **SANC for UNESCO IHP general terms and conditions**. This licence means that SANC for UNESCO IHP can **Share** (copy and redistribute the material in any medium or format) and **Adapt** (remix, transform, and build upon the material) any material received, while giving [appropriate credit](#) to the contestant as the original content creator and providing a link to the licence, and [indicating in case any changes were made](#).
3. SANC for UNESCO IHP will not apply edits e.g., in lightroom or photoshop, to the images received within the Photo Story Competition.
4. Within the Creative Commons licence above, all entrants understand that any image submitted to the competition may be used by SANC for UNESCO IHP and its competition partners, for marketing and promotional purposes of the author and the event after the announcement.
5. By signing this agreement SANC for UNESCO IHP and the contestant agree to potentially make use of the images received throughout the world in any media for any use connected to the promotion of the author and the Citizen Science for Water Photo Story Competition 2024/25 competition and/or exhibition event.
6. Any use of the received images, including any online publications, print, use at conferences, exhibitions, in videos, or on social media channels, including facebook, linkedin, twitter, instagram, weibo, wechat, and any similar channels, is always to be accompanied by an appropriate disclaimer that gives credit to the contestant as the original content creator and SANC for UNESCO IHP as organisers of the Citizen Science for Water Photo Story Competition 2024/25.
