Good news only for the Majakaneng Community in North West

23 April 2015

Residents of Extension 13 Samancor-Mamba in Majakaneng, North West can now breathe a sigh of relief as plans to assemble 108 toilets in the area are at an advanced stage. This forms part of the Department of Water and Sanitation's Majakaneng Water Intervention Project to alleviate water and sanitation backlogs in Majakaneng in the North West Province.

Currently, there are four fully operational boreholes that pump water to reservoirs that supply water in the area, while other additional boreholes are being constructed through the utilization of local contractors. This is to empower the local community while also providing full access to clean water to the previously water stressed area.

Meanwhile the Greater Madibeng Local Municipality will implement strict water conservation and water demand measures. The Local Municipality will enforce water restrictions in some of the water constrained areas in Madibeng as a way of stabilising water supply.

Engagement with the residents through Community Forums and the participation of Magalies Water Board is one of the key facilitators of this intervention and even more greater progress as time goes by.
