REQUIREMENTS: The ideal candidate for this role should have a BTech Engineering (Civil). It is important that the candidate is registered with the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA) as a Professional Engineer/Technologist and can provide proof of registration. Additionally, registration with the South African Council for Project and Construction Management Professions (SACPCMP) as a Professional Construction Manager (Pr. CM) is advantageous. The candidate must have ten years of relevant experience in construction management, planning, and supervision, particularly in implementing large water-related infrastructure projects. Must have extensive experience in project management and risk management, especially in the project management of large infrastructure projects. Experience in large water infrastructure projects would be beneficial. Project management skills like practical programme and project management will be an added advantage. The ideal candidate should also have extensive contract management experience, knowledge of Sector Legislation compliance, a detailed understanding of construction procurement processes, experience in construction project-related financial planning and financial management, knowledge of project risk analysis and risk management. Additionally, high-level communication skills (both verbal and written), conflict management, contract dispute resolution, and negotiation skills are essential. The candidate should have problem-solving and analysis skills and be proficient in computer applications such as MS Office, MS Projects, etc. They should be able to work independently, be self-motivated, responsible, and reliable. The disclosure of a valid unexpired driver's license.

DUTIES: The role requires the incumbent to assist the construction manager in managing all aspects of the project. Incumbent will be responsible for long and short-term programme planning and updating. Ensure that adequate resources are available to support the project programme. Manage operational activities to ensure production support the programme and in line with relevant legislation including health and safety regulations. Identify all none-conformity and implement remedial work as required. The incumbent will direct or redirect resources to achieve project objectives. Additionally, the incumbent will be responsible for personnel management. The incumbent will report directly to the Construction Manager.
